INFORMATION LETTER

This Bursary Programme is funded by Letsatsi Borutho Trust.

Letsatsi Borutho Trust invites bursary applications from the surrounding community. The bursary is open to persons who are South African citizens and want to study further at South African suitably registered tertiary institutions, notably TVET colleges, universities of technology or universities. Prospective students studying towards NQF level 4 technical and vocational education and training programmes, as well as national diploma and degree programmes are invited to apply. Persons who completed their NSC or NTC in previous years may also apply.

*NB Applicants must not exceed the age of 35 years.

Dear Applicant

Please read the instructions before completing the application form.

1. General rules

- 1.1 Only applications from qualifying persons within Letsatsi Borutho Trust's geographical operational area will be considered.
- 1.2 Only application forms completed correctly, in full and accompanied by the required supporting documents will be considered.
- 1.3 The completed application form must be submitted on or before 3 January 2019 to apply@studytrust.co.za or the Tlhokomelo Centre (address: 776 corner of Lecholo and Matanzima roads, Kimberley) if you want to be considered for a 2020 Letsatsi Borutho Trust bursary, administered by StudyTrust.

2. Required Documents

- 2.1 A copy of this year's June and prelim results; or your NSC if you completed Grade 12
- 2.2 A copy of your provisional admission letter to the institution you applied to study at
- 2.3 A copy of your ID document
- 2.4 Documentation proving the total monthly income of members of your household.

3. Selection Criteria

The main criteria used in the selection of successful applicants to the Letsatsi Borutho Trust bursary are as follows:

- 3.1 Financial need: Applicants must be able to demonstrate lack of sufficient financial resources to continue with tertiary education
- 3.2 Academic performance: Selection will be done on the basis of prelim/final Grade 12 results

4. Selection Process

A limited number of bursaries will be allocated to the most deserving candidates in terms of the above criteria.

5. Letsatsi Borutho Trust Bursary Value

The value of the bursary will be determined on an individual basis and may be used to cover the following study-related cost items:

- 5.1 Tertiary institution tuition fees, registration fees and examination fees
- 5.2 Accommodation in a tertiary residence or equivalent
- 5.3 Meals
- 5.4 Learning materials (textbooks, stationary, etc.)

6. Submitted Application Forms: Acknowledgement of Receipt and Outcome

- 6.1 Receipt: You will receive an email confirming receipt of your completed application form. All properly completed applications received will be considered.
- 6.2 Outcome: You may expect an email to the address provided in your application informing you of the provisional outcome of your application by 21 December.
- 6.3 If successful, you will be requested to submit your final NSC results. The bursary will only be confirmed if the final results correspond to the prelim results that formed the basis of the initial selection.
